Dear Artists and Craftspeople,

Saint Benedict School would like to invite you to participate in the 2011 Great Wallingford *Wurst Festival*, Friday September 16th and Saturday September 17th.

This year we will be focusing on vendors who sell hand-crafted items, rather than vendors who sell manufactured or imported goods. We will accept vendors whose merchandise best fit the family-friendly nature of the Wallingford Wurst Festival. Please note that state law prohibits the sale of anything that looks like a weapon (including swords and daggers) on school property.

*Applications are due by August 24rd.* At that time, we will begin assigning spaces. Late applicants will be accepted on a space-available basis only.

- The cost is \$75 per booth with a City of Seattle business license; \$85 per booth without one.
- Vendor *required* hours of operation are: 4pm to 9:30pm, Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>  
10am to 7:30pm, Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup>  
If you are interested in staying open later (the festival closes at 10pm, the Beer Garden closes at midnight), please note that on your application so we can place you in an appropriate space.
- Vendors must remain on site throughout the event.
- Spaces available:  
8 – 10 Indoor spaces 10' X 10'  
35 Outdoor spaces 10' X 10' (Vendors need to provide their own weatherproof booth. Only basic lighting is guaranteed for outdoor booths. Please call to inquire about the availability of any additional electrical, water or sewer needs.)
