

Wurst Fest Family Baking Assignments 2019

These assignments are for each child in the class.

As this is a “Bake Sale” we ask that everything be homemade.

8th Grade – 3 dozen cookies, medium size

7th Grade – 3 dozen cookies, no choc chip, medium size

6th Grade – 3 dozen “bar” cookies (lemon bars, blondies, seven-layer bars, etc.)

5th Grade – 2 pies, uncut: 1 for Thurs/Friday delivery and 1 for Saturday am delivery, if possible

4th Grade – 2 batches of rice crispy treats

3rd Grade – 2 pies, uncut: 1 for Thurs/Friday delivery and 1 for Saturday am delivery, if possible

2nd Grade – 2 batches of brownies/ribbon brownies (jam, cream cheese, peanut butter, etc.)

1st Grade – 3 dozen cookies, nut free, medium size

Kindergarten – 2 batches of brownies, nut free, frosting optional

Pre-school and Pre-K – 1 dozen cupcakes - easy to bake and fun to decorate!

*Please label all of your baked goods so we know specifically what they are.

*Additionally, please list your ingredients and clearly indicate if nut free.

For bar cookies, brownies and rice crispy treats, please cut them before dropping off! This will save us hours of prep time, thank you! If you are making pies, please leave them uncut.

For 9X13 pans – 12 pieces:



We can accept the goods starting Thursday afternoon, September 12, in the cafeteria – please complete the sign in sheet when dropping off. Please bring in your baked goods **no later than Friday at noon, Sept. 13.**
